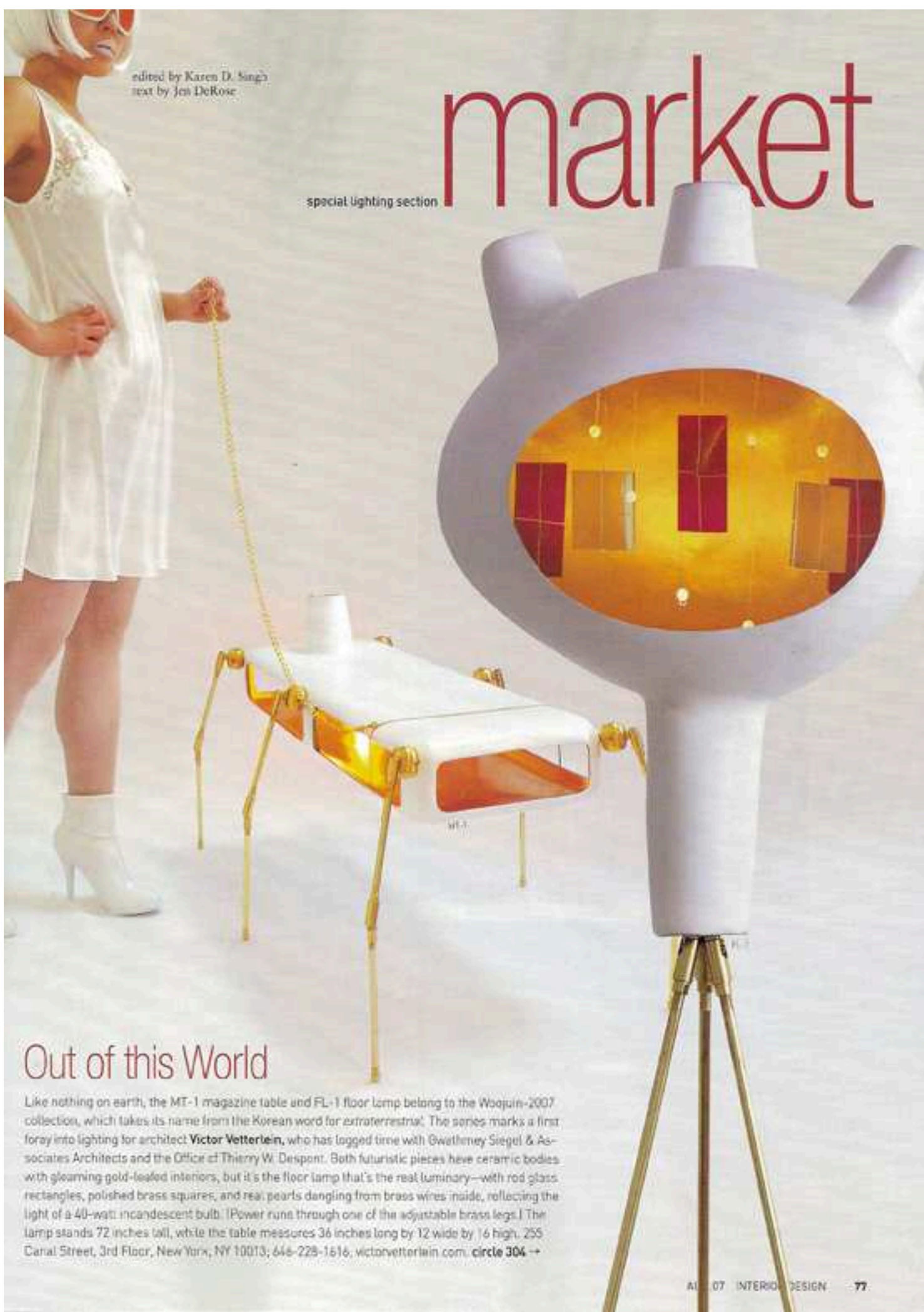

Out of this World

Like nothing on earth, the MT-1 magazine table and FL-1 floor lamp belong to the Woojin-2007 collection, which takes its name from the Korean word for extraterrestrial. The series marks a first foray into lighting for architect **Victor Vetterlein**, who has logged time with Gwathmey Siegel & Associates Architects and the Office of Thierry W. Despont. Both futuristic pieces have ceramic bodies with gleaming gold-leaded interiors, but it's the floor lamp that's the real luminary—with rod glass rectangles, polished brass squares, and real pearls dangling from brass wires inside, reflecting the light of a 40-watt incandescent bulb. (Power runs through one of the adjustable brass legs.)
